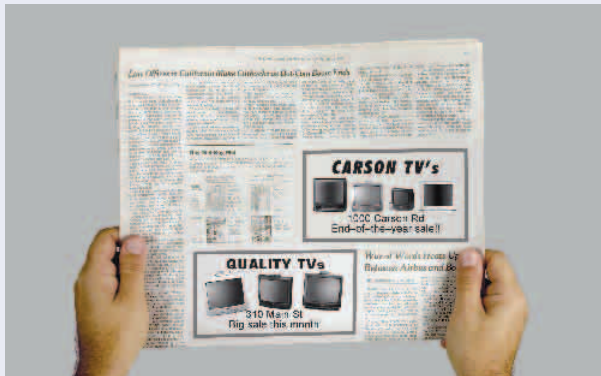

PLURAL OF ABBREVIATIONS
