

PREPOSITION + VERB + -ING

Take a look at this sentence.

By carpooling, America can save millions of gallons of gasoline a day.

In the sentence, we used *carpool* in the **-ing form after the preposition *by***.

Now look at some more examples.

Charles thought **about making** a commitment to his girlfriend.

prep. verb -ing

Mae and Tom are interested **in preserving** the environment.

prep. verb -ing

Speaking **of saving** energy, let's start to recycle.

prep. verb -ing

We use the **verb** in the **-ing form** when it comes **after a preposition**.
