

## DRILL PRACTICE

Now let's do a different kind of drill.

1. Maureen and Belinda are having a party on Saturday. Maureen just found out that Belinda hasn't told any of their friends about the party yet.

**Models:**

*"Why didn't you tell Larry about the party?"*

*"I tried to call him yesterday, but I couldn't get through."*

*"Why didn't you tell Mona about the party?"*

*"I tried to call her yesterday, but I couldn't get through."*

Now you.

- a. Why didn't you tell Bob and Tom about the party?
- b. Why didn't you tell Tina about the party?
- c. Why didn't you tell Andrew about the party?
- d. Why didn't you tell Jim and Linda about the party?
- e. Why didn't you tell Mary Jane about the party?

2. Dave is talking to his friend Sandra about some things he should stop doing, and Sandra is giving him some advice. Listen to their conversation.

**Models:**

*"If I don't stop doing so much weightlifting, I'm going to have health problems."*

*"You'd better stop doing so much weightlifting."*

*"If I don't stop drinking and driving, I'm going to hurt someone."*

*"You'd better stop drinking and driving."*

Now you.

- a. If I don't stop doing so much exercise, I'm going to hurt myself.
- b. If I don't stop eating so much, I'm going to put on weight.
- c. If I don't stop drinking so much coffee, I'm going to get sick.
- d. If I don't stop sleeping at work, I'm going to get fired.
- e. If I don't stop having so many parties, I'm going to get in trouble.
