

DRILL PRACTICE

1. Some kinds of food smell really wonderful while they're cooking. Listen to Tom talking about some of his and his friends' favorites.

Model: *I love to smell **bread baking**.*

(Dora — meat being fried)

Dora loves to smell meat being fried.

Now you: **I love to smell bread baking.**

(Jerry — turkey roasting) (Julian — popcorn popping)

(Scott — cookies baking) (Kris — marshmallows roasting)

(George — coffee being made)

2. Brian doesn't enjoy living with his younger brother Stuart. Listen to him complaining.

Model: *I found Stuart **wearing my jacket**.*

(eating my cookies)

I found Stuart eating my cookies.

Now you: I found Stuart **wearing my jacket.**

(drinking my juice) (using my comb) (wearing my best shoes)

(eating my candy bars) (giving my cookies to the dog)

3. Listen to Joanne talking about what she and her boyfriend did on their summer vacation.

Model: *We spent some time **working in the backyard**.*

(hiking in the mountains)

We spent some time hiking in the mountains.

Now you: We spent some time **working in the backyard.**

(visiting friends) (painting the house) (lying on the beach)

(playing on the computer) (driving in the countryside)
