INTRODUCTION

The four-level series *Kids' Adventures in English* (KAE) is designed for young learners who are six and seven years old.

The objective of the series is to teach some of the basic vocabulary and structures of the English language to children who are beginning their study of English. Learning takes place through oral and written exercises, involving the development of the child's listening skills.

In KAE 2, students do not learn how to write the words they have learned orally. At this point in the child's development, when he or she is learning how to read and write in his or her native language, learning the written form of a foreign language would interfere with the teaching of reading and writing in the student's native language. For this reason, the exercises in this book aim to develop the child's coordination skills, listening skills, and visual perception, as well as his or her ability to make comparisons, to identify groups, and to judge distances. English is used in all of these activities.

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
