

# INTRODUCTION

The four-level series *Kids' Adventures in English* (KAE) is designed for young learners who are six and seven years old.

The objective of the series is to teach some of the basic vocabulary and structures of the English language to children who are beginning their study of English. Learning takes place through oral and written exercises, involving the development of the child's listening skills.

In KAE 3, there is no writing practice. This is to avoid interference problems which might arise for students who are learning to read and write in their native language. Students will only identify the written forms of words and expressions they have learned orally. For this reason, the exercises in this book aim to develop three language skills: listening, speaking, and reading. English is used in all activities involving these skills.
