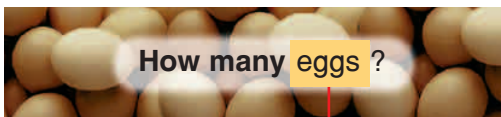

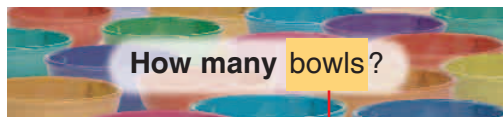

Mary: **How many** cups, Dad?

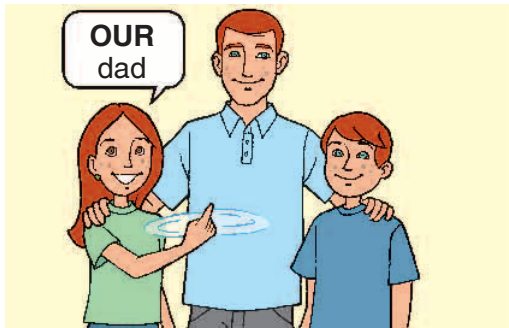
Mr. Garret: One, honey.

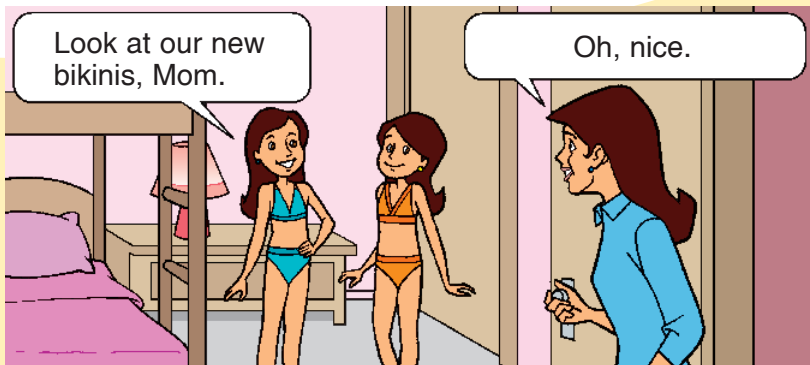


OUR + singular noun
