Because of our special teaching technique, the students exchange a ticket for the stickers of a lesson text only after all the oral classroom work for that lesson has been completed.

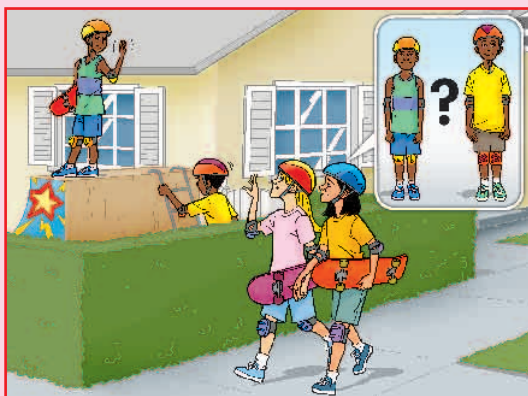
