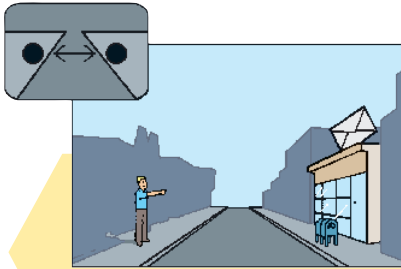
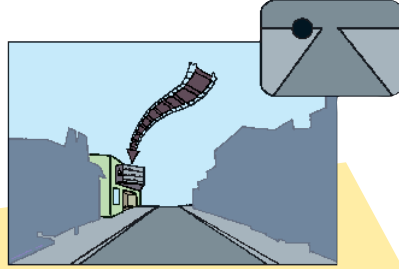


WHERE IS . . . ?

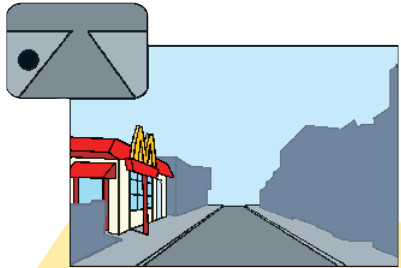
There are lots of ways of describing location. Look at all the ways you already know.



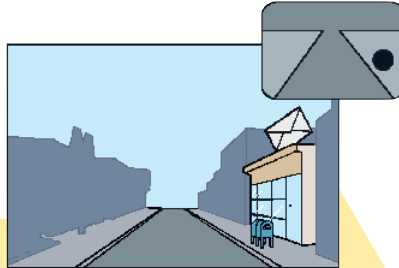
"The post office is **across** the street."



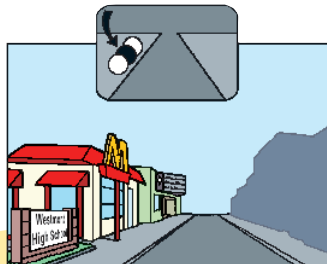
The movie theater is **at the end of** the street.

The post office is **on the right**.



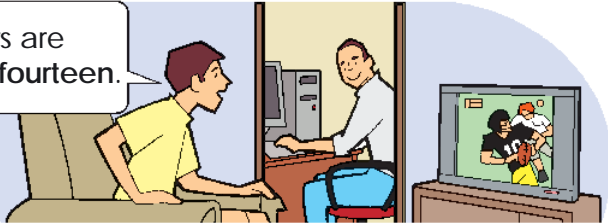
McDonald's® is **between** Westmont High School and the movie theater.

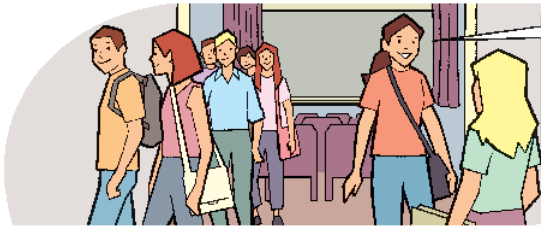
