

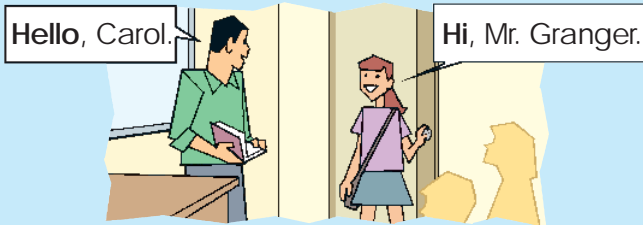
USING WHAT
YOU'VE LEARNED

IN EVERYDAY SPOKEN ENGLISH . . .

Look at this situation and notice how Carol and her friend Jaime greet each other.



Now observe how Mr. Granger, Carol's teacher, greets Carol.



When Carol and her friend Jaime meet each other they use the greetings *hi* and *hey*. Mr. Granger uses the word *hello* to greet Carol. *Hello* is a more formal greeting than *hi* or *hey*.



In everyday spoken English, people say *hi* more often than *hello*.
