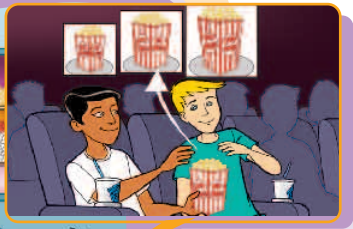


TL: Should we get 20- or 32-ounce drinks?

1 HELPFUL CLASSMATES

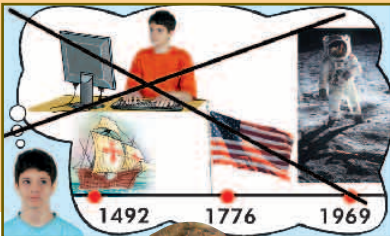


BL: Was Jesse in class yesterday?

4 G: TVs were very different in those days. I'll show you.

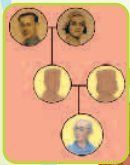
1 MEMORIES



G: See. Here we are watching TV on Thanksgiving.

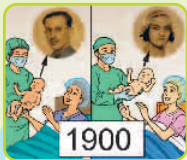


GS: Gosh! That's Grandma!

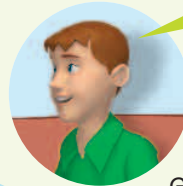


2 GS: And who are these people, Grandpa? I don't recognize them.
