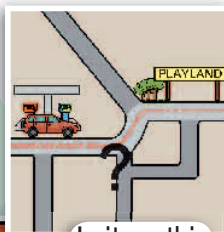
ASKING FOR DIRECTIONS AT A GAS STATION



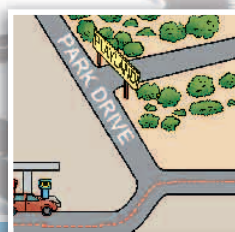

near here?



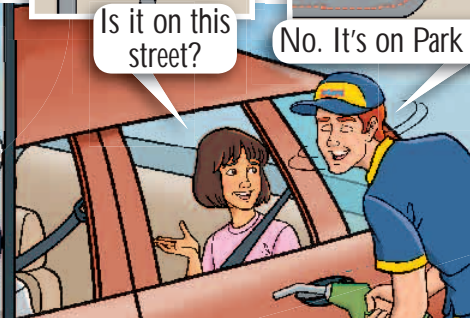
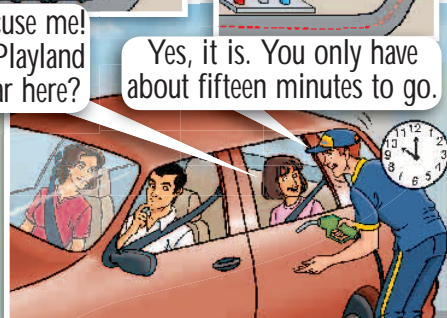

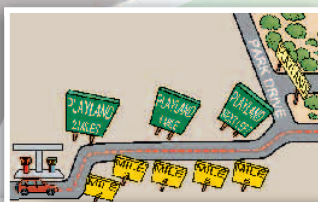
Is it on this
