

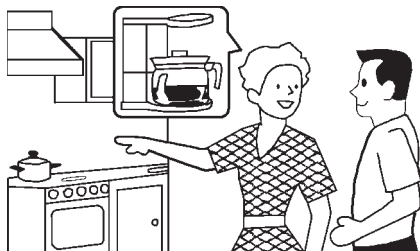

More examples:



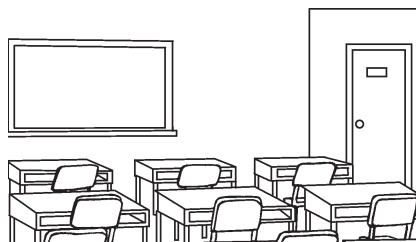
"There is **some** coffee in the kitchen."
