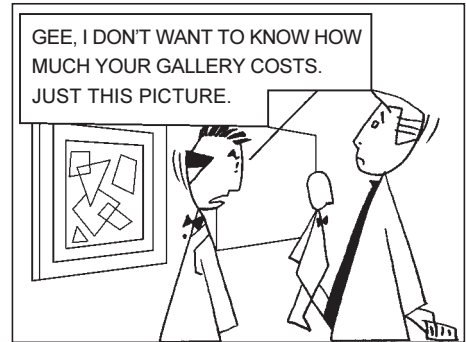
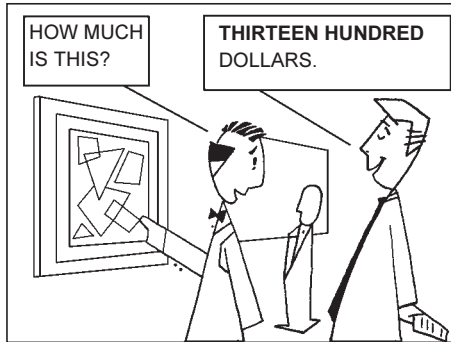


## HOW TO SAY 4-DIGIT NUMBERS ENDING IN 00

Say this way

|              |   |

| <b>1,500</b> | <b>a/one thousand five hundred<br/>or<br/>fifteen hundred</b> |

Now look how we say year numbers, page numbers, house or building numbers, and room numbers when they have 4 digits and end in 00:

Say this way

| <b>1900</b> | <b>nineteen hundred</b> |

| <b>2300 Jordan Street</b> | <b>twenty-three hundred</b> |

but there's only one way to say 4-digit numbers that end in 000:

| <b>2000</b> | <b>two thousand</b> |
