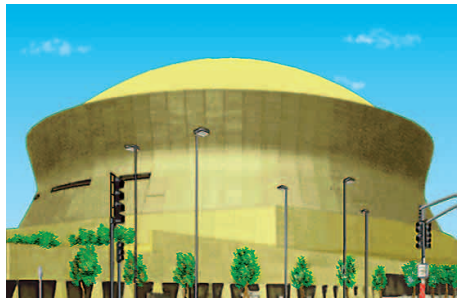


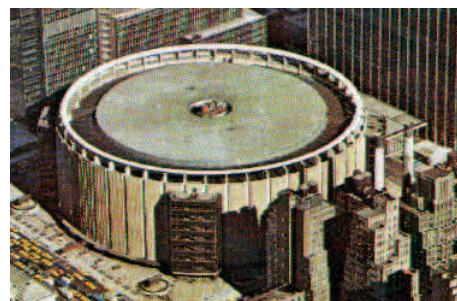
STADIUMS AND ARENAS* IN THE U.S.



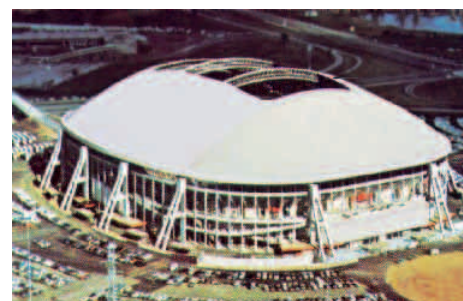
The Superdome, in New Orleans, with movable seating, can accommodate between 20,000 and 100,000.



The Meadowlands Sports Complex, in New Jersey, includes an outdoor stadium, an indoor arena, and a horse racetrack.



The **Madison Square Garden** was the first indoor arena opened in New York City.



The **Texas Stadium** can seat 65,101 people and is home to the Dallas Cowboys professional football team.
