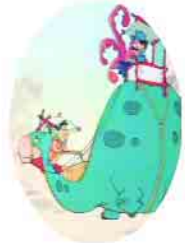
WILMA:

I'm an expert driver.



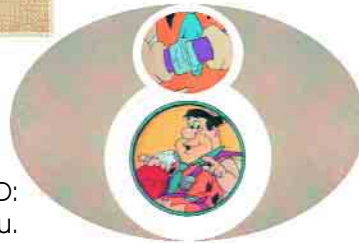
WILMA:
Look out!



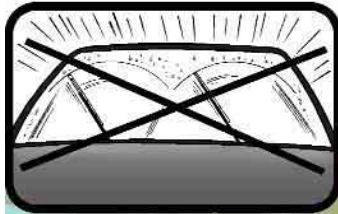
FRED:
